# THE BAND OF BROTHERS, ROAD TO LIBERTY TOUR

75th Anniversary of D-Day July 7 to 20, 2019

**Sunday, July 7th, 2019** We depart the USA for Paris, France.

Monday, July 8<sup>th</sup> We arrive at Paris Charles de Gaulle airport in the morning to meet our tour manager David Harper. We transfer by private coach to the Calvados region in Normandy making a stop at the pretty village of Beuvron-en-Auge en route, as well as stopping at a Calvados distillery. In the afternoon we check into Royal Hotel <a href="https://www.caenhotel.com">www.caenhotel.com</a> in the heart of Caen. Dinner and overnight Caen, Normandy.

Tuesday, July 9th After breakfast, we make a full-day excursion: first to Utah Beach and the D-Day Landing Museum of Ste Marie-du-Mont, then, passing through the 101st Airborne paratroopers' drop-zone, to the village of Ste Mère l'Eglise where we have time for lunch and visit the Airborne Museum. We also stop at the monuments dedicated to "Iron Mike" and to Major Dick Winters of Easy Company fame. Late afternoon we continue to the famous Pointe du Hoc, with its 100-foot cliff overlooking the English Channel. This evening we have some time to explore the town. Dinner and overnight Caen, Normandy.

**Wednesday, July 10**th After breakfast, we make a full-day excursion, first to **Arromanches** where we visit the splendid 360-degree **circular cinema** above the former Mulberry Harbor. After visiting the Arromanches artificial harbor museum we have free time for lunch before continuing to the **Normandy American Cemetery** overlooking Omaha Beach. Here are the remains of 9,387 American military dead. This cemetery was used in the opening scenes of the 1998 film *Saving Private Ryan*. From here we will visit the **German defense bunkers at Longues** (as seen in the popular 1962 film *The Longest Day*). If time permits we'll take in the world-famous **William the Conqueror "tapestry" in Bayeux**. Dinner and overnight Caen, Normandy.

<u>Thursday, July 11<sup>th</sup></u> After breakfast we leave early for **Reims** where we pay a visit to **General Eisenhower's HQs**, the site of the **official surrender of the German Armed Forces**. We then continue on to the charming country inn of La Grande Cure <u>www.lagrandecure.be/en</u> near Marcourt, Belgium. Dinner and overnight Marcourt.

Friday, July 12<sup>th</sup> After breakfast we take a daytrip to Bastogne to explore the sights, memorials and extensive museum connected to the Battle of the Bulge – where the Band of Brothers' greatest trials took place. We also visit the remnants of foxholes dug by the 101<sup>st</sup> at "Bois Jacques". On the way back to our hotel we may stop at a Belgian brewery. Dinner and overnight Marcourt.

<u>Saturday, July 13<sup>th</sup></u> After breakfast we leave for **Diekirch** in the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg to visit the **World War II Museum's** large collection. We then pay our respects to **General Patton's grave** at the US military cemetery near Luxembourg City before driving on to Bitche where we spend the night at Relais des Forteresses. <a href="https://www.hoteldurelais-bitche.com">www.hoteldurelais-bitche.com</a> Dinner and overnight Bitche.

<u>Sunday, July 14<sup>th</sup></u> After breakfast we'll tour the impressive <u>Simserhof Maginot Line</u> fort at Bitche. Later this afternoon we visit part of the famed <u>Siegfried Line</u> near Pirmasens, Germany, before driving on to <u>Nuremberg</u>. Overnight Hotel Victoria <u>www.hotelvictoria.de/en.html</u> in the heart of Nuremberg. Dinner nearby. Overnight Nuremberg.

<u>Monday, July 15<sup>th</sup></u> After breakfast we visit the former Nazi Party Rally Grounds: the Luitpold field, Zeppelin tribune, SS training school and the Congress Hall building. We'll also visit the museum attached to "Courtroom 600" where the Nuremberg Trials

took place. After some free time in Nuremberg's old town we'll be served dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight Nuremberg.

<u>Tuesday, July 16<sup>th</sup></u> After breakfast we leave early to drive to **Dachau** for a tour of the **Concentration Camp Memorial Site**. In the afternoon we travel south to Berchtesgaden. Overnight Hotel Edelweiss <u>www.edelweiss-berchtesgaden.com</u> in Berchtesgaden's historic town center.

<u>Wednesday, July 17<sup>th</sup></u> After breakfast we depart to visit the site of **Hitler's alpine headquarters** at Obersalzberg: underground tunnel complex, many original buildings of the 3rd Reich southern seat of power, the **3rd Reich History Museum** and, naturally, the **Eagle's Nest** with free time for lunch in Hitler's dining room or on the terrace. Late afternoon, we can enjoy some free time in the old town before dinner. Overnight Hotel Edelweiss Berchtesgaden.

<u>Thursday, July 18<sup>th</sup></u> After breakfast, we visit the **Altaussee salt mine** in Austria where Hitler's regime hid precious artwork (as seen in the 2014 film *The Monuments Men*). In the afternoon we visit charming **Salzburg, Austria**. Dinner and overnight Berchtesgaden.

Friday, July 19<sup>th</sup> After breakfast we travel to the spectacular Neuschwanstein Castle where Nazi-looted artwork was stored. In the afternoon we take a short driving tour through Munich to view the buildings connected to the 3<sup>rd</sup> Reich's presence in Munich (Königsplatz, Führer's Headquarters, Haus der Kunst, etc). After a short visit to the pedestrianized city center, including the famed Hofbrauhaus, we transfer to Hotel Erdinger Weissbrau <a href="https://www.hotels-erdinger-erding.de">www.hotels-erdinger-erding.de</a> for our farewell dinner. Overnight Erding.

**Saturday, July 20**<sup>th</sup> Early morning we transfer to Munich airport for our flight home.
